



The Group Financial Performance

A Noteworthy Financial Performance as at End 2012

The Group pursued its strategy of development of its activities and the achievement of sound financial performance results. Such results were translated in a remarkable growth of 8.7% in the Group's total assets to reach USD 16.14 billion, during the first half of 2013, compared to end of June 2012, thus sustaining the Group's ranking in Lebanon as the 4th largest financial institution in terms of Assets, Customers' Deposits, Net Profits and Shareholders' Equity. During the first half of 2013, the Group maintained its 3rd position within the Lebanese banking sector rankings in terms of Net Loans and Advances to Customers.

The below financial indicators of the group as at 30.06.13 reflect these achievements:

- During the first half of 2013, the Group's net profits amounted to USD 72.68 million with a growth rate of 10.4%, a rate being amongst the highest in the sector, as compared to the same period of 2012.
- Customers' Deposits totaled USD 13.52 billion in the first six months of 2013 with a growth rate of 8.5% as compared to end of June 2012.
- During the same period, Net Loans and Advances to Customers totaled USD 4.96 billion, with a growth rate of 9.5% as compared to end of June 2012.
- Shareholder's Equity amounted to USD 1.51 billion, reflecting a growth rate of 16.9% as compared to end of June 2012.

- Coverage ratio of non-performing loans (excluding collective provisions): 84.33%, Coverage ratio of non-performing loans (including collective provisions and guarantees): 109.78%.
- Solvency Ratio (Basel III) at 12.23%, exceeding the standards required by the Central Bank of Lebanon, which are also higher than the minimum level required by Basel III of 8%, and Primary Liquidity to Customers' Deposits Ratio at 52.24%.

The First-of-its Kind Retail Index in Lebanon The Beirut Traders Association – Fransabank Retail Index

In collaboration with Beirut Traders Association, Fransabank launched the first retail index in Lebanon in 2012, the "Beirut Traders Association – Fransabank Retail Index", providing the Lebanese economy with an index that is indicative of the retail trade sector in Lebanon, for the trade sector in general as well as its constituent Beirut traders in particular.

This Retail Index is announced on a quarterly basis and is based on scientific research on the micro and macro economies, as well as sectorial studies, which had been lacking in a comprehensive manner in the market and are practically inexistent in some other sectors.

"Beirut Traders Association – Fransabank Retail Index" objective is to contribute in improving the traders' decision-making competencies, which can now be based on thorough scientific studies; this will inevitably enhance traders' competitiveness in the market and add value to the national economy as well as the consumer.

For the 2rd quarter of 2013, the index was issued with a base index 100 fixed at the fourth quarter of 2011, and with a BTA quarterly inflation rate estimate of 1.1% between March 2013 and June 2013. BTA- Fransabank Retail Index stood as 86.88. In other words, the overall retail trade activity has witnessed, during the second quarter of 2013, a continued decline in comparison to the previous quarter (Q1 '13), and can be considered as the lowest since the end of 2011.

If this trend persists, and if the main seasonal and festive periods continue to be lost opportunities for retail traders, Beirut Traders Association's projection for economic growth for this year is zero percent, because of the importance of the weight of the commercial sector in the GDP, a projection that concurs with estimates revealed by a certain number of reliable foreign agencies.

Network Reach

With its 116 branches dispersed all over the nation, the Group asserts once again its position as the largest local branch network in Lebanon.

In line with its customers' service and local expansion strategies, Fransabank Group announced the relocation of its Ashrafieh Saydeh branch to Rmeil, the opening of its new branch in Mreijeh in Beirut and in Maarad Str. in Tripoli.

Fransabank Grants Financial Support in Fulfillment of Yaduna's Aspiration to Promote Women's Cardiovascular Health







Amicably at Jabal Moussa



Among its social, cultural and recreational events which strengthen its "Fransabank Family" spirit, the Amicale Club designed and executed an adventurous trip to Keserwan-Jbeil area, Lebanon, and a dear neighbor to the Mediterranean Sea to the west; Jabal Moussa.

The trip to this outstanding Biosphere Reserve was full of fun, suspense, and venture, in a spot which reflects a true mosaic of ecological systems, representing the bio-geographical region of the greenish forests and leafy shrubs. The mountain covers an area of 6500ha at an altitude ranging between 350m and 1700m; and extends 500m beyond the rivers of Nahr Ibrahim to the north and Nahr el Dahab to the south.

On that day, Fransabank adventures explored closely a dominant feat of the biosphere reserve which is its sappy mountainsides rising from a river lined with cool odorous and fragrant sycamore trees, to reach honorable karstic rocks peaks. They recognized how the Biosphere Reserve is divided into a

core area mainly dedicated to expert visits and research, a buffer zone where more ecotourism activities take place, and a transition zone that involves human activities and human use of land. The transition zone covers around half of the biosphere reserve's area, and its predominant land uses include: forest management, charcoal production, traditional agricultural activities, fruit trees plantation, grazing, and seasonal recreation.

Initiated and embraced by the Bank's workforce, the Amicale Club has been always funded generously from the management to support such enthusiastic activities of social, educational, ecological, and entertainment dimensions.
